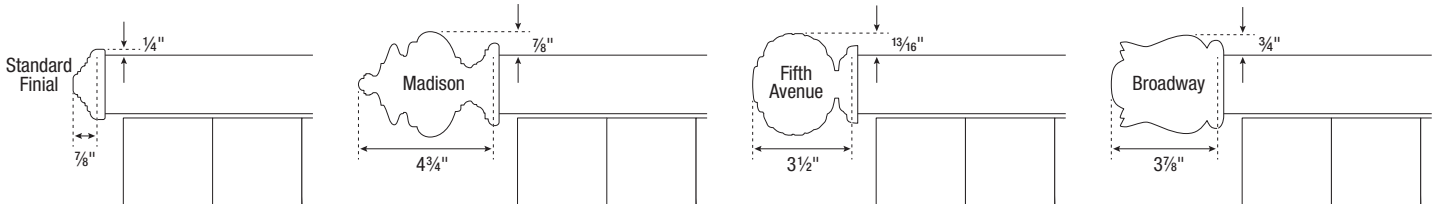
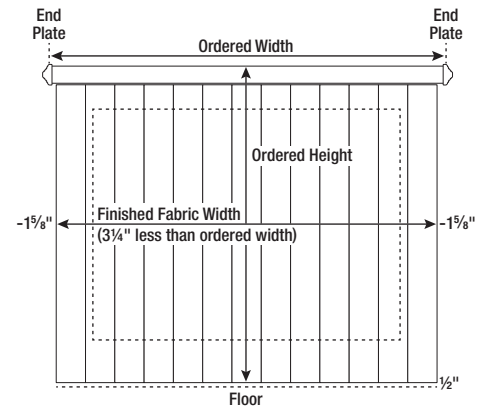
ORDER FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Manhattan™ Decorative Hardware System — Manual

1 Specify the quantity of sheers or draperies with identical dimensions and fabric.

2 Specify dimensions — sheer or drapery width and height (round to the nearest 1/8").

- The width measurement is the desired width of the rail — end plate to end plate. The height measurement is the height of the fabric plus the rail. See illustration at right.
- Finished fabric width is 3/4" less than the ordered width when the vanes are not tilted.
- The Manhattan™ Decorative Hardware system is outside (OB) mount. To minimize light gaps, we recommend overlapping the opening by 5" on the sides and 5"–7" on the top for Classic 3 1/2" vane sizes; for Quintette™ 4 3/4" vane sizes, overlap the sides by 6" and the top by 6"–8". If the product hangs to the floor, deduct 1/2" for clearance.
- For a completely uncovered window or door opening, refer to the stackback charts in the Luminette® section of the Hunter Douglas Reference Guide.
- **Important!** Check that the added width of rail ends and finials, and the added height of finials, will allow you to mount the Manhattan Decorative Hardware system in the desired location. You must have sufficient top and side clearance to attach the finials. Refer to the illustrations below.



3 For Dual Panel orders, specify widths for drapery panels and sheer portion.

- Specify left drapery, sheer portion and right drapery widths; these dimensions must equal the finished fabric width. Drapery panels must be equal. Refer to the Luminette section in the Hunter Douglas Reference Guide for Dual Panel ordering guidelines.

4 Specify fabric number and color number.

- For Dual Panel orders, specify fabric and color numbers for both Privacy Sheers and Modern Draperies.

5 Specify panel configuration: Traditional™ or Ribbon™.

- Traditional panel design — contoured fabric columns with vanes attached.
- Ribbon panel design — seamless rippled fabric without vanes attached.

6 Specify rail style: fluted or smooth.

7 Specify hardware color (wand, rail and installation hardware): Bronze — 528; Oro — 191; Champagne — 534.

8 If optional finial is ordered, specify style: Madison, Fifth Avenue or Broadway.

- If no finial is specified, a color-coordinated standard finial will be included.

9 Specify finial color: New Bronze — 101; Antique Gold — 102; Brushed Platinum — 103.

10 Specify left, right, split or offset stack.

- Wand/Cord is located on same side of stack for side stack applications.
- Offset stack available with Modern Draperies Dual Panel only.

11 Specify wand/cord location (for split and offset stack only).

12 Specify if any spacer blocks, extension brackets, XL extension brackets or ceiling (CB) mount brackets are required.

- Two spacer blocks come standard with outside (OB) mount Classic 3 1/2" vane sizes and four spacer blocks come standard with outside mount Quintette 4 3/4" vane sizes. A maximum of four spacer blocks may be used.
- Ceiling mount brackets are used with extension brackets for added clearance. Mounting Manhattan rail to the ceiling, however, is not recommended.
- Finials cannot be used with ceiling mounts.
